Admission

The department admits 105 students per semester.

Seven percentage of admissions are available to students from non-European countries qualified to study at higher education institutions.

Admission Requirements:

- Qualifications for higher education recognized as equivalent to those in Germany
- German language proficiency: International applicants without a German educational qualification need to pass a DSH (level 2) or TestDaf (level 4x4) examination.

The Bonn-Rhine-Sieg University of Applied Sciences offers a preparatory course for the DSH examination.

Applicants should contact the Registrar's Office to check if they fulfil the admission requirements and to receive more information about the DSH examination.

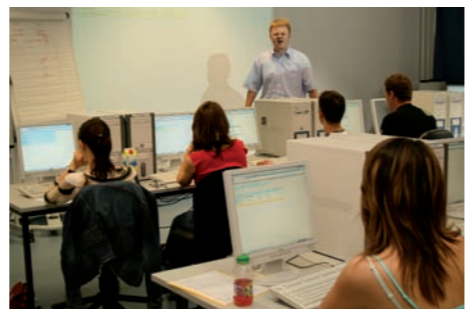

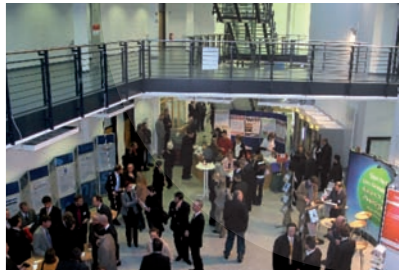

Cooperation with Companies

- Compulsary internship of at least 20 weeks
- Bachelor's Thesis in cooperation with companies/ institutions
- Students' projects with business partners
- Business talk: guest speakers from businesses

The Department of Business Administration cooperates with many companies and institutions in particular in the region. Therefore, the students have the possibility to find an employer for their internship and an interesting topic for their Bachelor's Thesis. Due to the close cooperation with companies in the region relevant business issues are integrated into the program. Students' and research projects are offered through company cooperations.

Excellent Learning and Teaching Environment

- Concrete examples and case studies facilitate the comprehension of the teaching contents
- Exercises and feedback sessions safeguard the single learning steps
- Small classes
- Individual counselling by professors and academic advisors
- Additional support through tutorials offered by students

We expect from our students a high degree of motivation, continuous commitment, initiative and personal responsibility for managing their studies.

Internationality

- The department cooperates with international partner universities in European and non-European countries, e.g. Robert Gordon University (Scotland), Coastal Carolina University (USA), Pfeiffer University (USA), Murdoch University (Australia), University of Economics - Varna (Bulgaria), Institute of Technology Tralee (Ireland), Université de Poitiers (France).
- Many foreign language classes are offered by our Language Centre, e.g. Business English, Business French, Business Spanish.

Instead of the compulsory internship the students can study abroad.

Bachelor's Thesis

The program is completed after seven semesters with an oral examination and a written Bachelor's Thesis. This Thesis is a written assignment on a defined topic. In addition to the Bachelor's Thesis a Bachelor's Seminar supports the students by offering a base for research in methodology and theory.
